SIXTH EDITION

Participation Rules

Art. 1. The "Father Diego Donati o.f.m." Association announces and organizes the sixth Edition of the Biennial of Contemporary Graphics - DIEGO DONATI Prize - with free theme. The exhibition will be held online from 4 December 2020 to 3 January 2021.

Art. 2. Participation in the competition is open to Italian and foreign artists and is subject to compliance with all the conditions contained in these rules.

Art.3. Each artist can submit a maximum of two works for examination by the commission. It is possible to participate with works produced by using chalcographic techniques: etching, aquatint, drypoint, burin, soft paint, black manner and xylography. Excluded are: lithography, screen printing, offset printing and all other technical printing techniques. Works of the past three years can be presented. Engravings must be scanned to high resolution Jpeg (300 dpi) or Tiff formats for inclusion in the catalogue.

Art. 4. The commission reserves the right to exclude from the competition works that do not prove to comply with the characteristics and limits indicated above, and those that are, for any reason, unsuitable for exhibition.

Art. 5. Works must be sent along with the participation form filled in all its parts.

Art. 6. Each author must transmit, together with the participation form, a Word file (to be sent by email) containing a brief biographical note that should not exceed one thousand characters, including spaces.

Art. 7. The deadline for presentation of material is 10 October 2020.

Art. 8. The Jury will evaluate all the works that will be received in the forms and within the deadline mentioned above. The work selected by the Jury will be published in the catalogue. The JURY's judgment will be unquestionable.

Art. 9. By 10 November 2020 each participant will be informed of the outcome of the selection by email. The artists who will receive a special mention from the Jury will be highlighted in the catalogue.

Art. 10. The announcement of the winning work will take place on the occasion of the Biennial inauguration. Further information will be provided.

Art. 11. A personal exhibition will be organized for the winner in 2021 at the "Diego Donati" Gallery or in an exhibition space identified by the Association and located within the municipality of Perugia. Date and conditions will be agreed on.

Art. 12. The "Father Diego Donati o.f.m." Association will produce a PDF catalogue which can be downloaded from the Association website.

Art. 13. By sending and signing the participation form, each Artist implicitly declares to be fully aware of all the articles of the regulation; non compliance, even with only one article, may result in the exclusion from the exhibition.

Art.14. We ensure that personal data will be processed in accordance with current privacy laws.
